Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:



Work at a commercial or industrial facility within Pepco's service territory for at least 50% of their working hours.



Be in a position of responsibility for energy management in the facility or have the potential to influence the building's energy performance.

Incentives

Each approved applicant will be eligible to receive a financial incentive that covers up to \$1,000 per course.* The applicant must submit proof of attendance via a certificate of completion or other similar documentation to receive the incentive.

Applicants must apply for and receive pre-approval from Pepco before enrolling in a course. A list of prequalified courses can be found at **pepco.com/OMT**. In addition, applicants and employers can propose other relevant courses for Pepco's consideration.
